

Teacher's Guide

The theme for this assignment is the increasing number of endangered species worldwide. Most of the material is based on the International Union for Conservation of Nature's (IUCN) research on global biodiversity.

For the sake of the general overview of young students, I have summed the critically endangered and the endangered species in the graphs on the worksheets.

What to do:

- Divide your class into fitting groups depending on age, purpose and personalities.
- Give each group the 5 worksheets as pdf file or printed.
- You have several possibilities
 - Let the groups answer the questions and write the answers down as an assignment.
 - Let the groups answer some or all the questions and present it to the class.
 - Let the groups answer a few questions and send them around to the other groups to explain.

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
